Comprehensive vehicle protection

Exclusionary coverage is the highest level of protection available for your vehicle — and the best value for your budget. Exclusionary includes systems and components listed under both Powertrain and Comprehensive Component coverage, excluding only those items listed as not covered on your service agreement, including:

- Routine maintenance items: Oil, coolant, fluids and refrigerant.
- Items that occasionally need replacement: Battery and cables, lights and bulbs, tires, filters, hoses and lines, drive belts, brake pads, drums and shoes, exhaust system, shock absorbers and strut insert cartridges.
- Appearance concerns and exterior items: Bright metal, vinyl, wheel covers, glass, ornaments and paint.
- Interior items: Carpet, upholstery buttons and door and window handles.

Exclusionary Wrap

For vehicles under factory warranty

Most factory warranties only cover the essential components of your vehicle, such as the engine and transmission. Repair and replacement of other systems and components can be costly. Get more protection for your vehicle by "wrapping" exclusionary coverage around the basic coverage offered by your warranty.

Comprehensive

Powertrain coverage plus critical components

Stated coverage includes components listed under the Powertrain protection plan as well as the following:

Engine cooling system: Fan, fan clutch and fan motor.

Factory air conditioning: Condenser, compressor, evaporator, dryer, temperature control programmer, seals and gaskets.

Front suspension: Struts; upper and lower control arms, shafts and bushings; upper and lower ball joints; stabilizer shaft; linkage and bushings; spindles and supports; and wheel bearings.

Steering: All internal lubricated parts; rack and pinion and all internal parts; power cylinder assembly, power steering pump, main and intermediate steering shafts and couplings; tie rods and tie rod ends; idler arm; and pitman arm.

Fuel system: Fuel pump, fuel injection pump, lines, nozzles and vacuum pump.

Brakes: Master cylinder: power brake booster, wheel cylinders; hydraulic lines and fittings; and disc calipers.

Electrical: Alternator, voltage regulator, distributor, starter motor, starter drive and solenoid: electronic ignition module, wiring harnesses, manually operated switches, wiper motor, power window motor and sunroof motor.

Electronic high-tech components: Level control compressor, sensors and limiter valve; pneumatic suspension pump, sensors and valves; fuel injection sensors and control module; ignition module; spark control detonation sensors and controller: drive information display and module; moisture control unit and sensors; anti-detonation sensors; manufacturerinstalled combination entry system; manufacturer-installed anti-theft device; and anti-lock braking system (ABS).

Electrical: All power motors and solenoids related to the electrical operations of antennas, door locks, power headlight motors, seat motors, mirrors, convertible tops and power trunk releases.

Factory-installed navigational system: Display, controls and all electrical components.

If your vehicle already has an underlying extended powertrain warranty, add a Comprehensive Component Wrap to cover all components listed under Comprehensive coverage, excluding components listed under Powertrain coverage. (Not available on all plans.)

Note: Cases, housings, engine block and cylinder heads are covered only if damaged by the
